Note 1: The post of SA/Exe, being an operational post, is not reserved for any category (HH, OH, VH & Autism) of PwD. Hence, they NEED NOT apply. However, there is a provision for reservation for all categories (HH, OH, VH & Autism) (except 100% blind) of PwD for the post of MTS/Gen.

Note 2: The reservation of vacancies for OBC, SC, ST, EWS, Ex-Servicemen & PwDs is as per rules/roster.

Note 3: The candidate can opt for the post of SA/Exe or MTS/Gen or both. In case, a candidate opts for both the posts, he would be initially considered for the post of SA/Exe & then for the post of MTS/Gen. However, in case, he is finally selected for the post of SA/Exe, his candidature for the post of MTS/Gen would stand cancelled.
